DeMolay Unit of Egypt Shrine

The DeMolay Unit of Egypt Shriners was originally established in the mid-1980s as a social (non-parading) Unit to unite all Nobles of Egypt Temple who were Senior DeMolays (meaning, they had been DeMolay members in their youth). Over time, that mission blurred just a bit, and the Unit also welcomed Nobles who served as registered DeMolay Advisors.

Today, the DeMolay Unit is open to ANY Noble, regardless of their prior membership or current service to DeMolay, so long as the Noble has an interest in the promotion and perpetuity of the Masonic Youth groups.

One additional duty we have assumed is that of acquiring volunteers for temple events, when requested by the Potentate and/or Divan officers. For example, we are asked to work the Fair Day, and we bring youth members to assist. This allows the Divan to have one point of contact (our President), and we disseminate the request through our network to get youth members to sign up. Same for the Temple Christmas Party and, until recent years, the Shrine Circus. (The Circus became way too arduous).

We amended our bylaws in 2019 to have stated meetings on ODD months, with social outings on EVEN months. However, we are dark for June, July, and August, at the order of the Unit officers. Our stated meetings are at Hillsborough Lodge, usually on the 4th Mondays at 7:00 pm. Business is kept to a minimum, and we usually discuss the status of local Masonic youth - since most of us are active with the youth groups.
