Scottish Rite News

Freemasonry neither enters into nor settles matters of religious opinion or doctrine. While it emphasizes the right of private belief, Freemasonry does assert the existence of Deity and makes inquiry into His Nature. Hence, many sacred texts provide source material for the ritual work.

The Scottish Rite includes four degrees termed the “religious degrees.” The 23rd degree, Chief of the Tabernacle, introduces lesser mysteries familiar to most men. The 24th, Prince of the Tabernacle, examines mysteries of the Hebraic faith; the 25th, Knight of the Brazen Serpent, considers Islam and the 26th degree, Prince of Mercy, Christianity.

These degrees enable the Craft to consider what each faith has in common regarding morality, values, virtue and right conduct – matters important to Masons of all faiths.

Pike’s lecture to the 26th degree in Morals and Dogma provides helpful instruction regarding belief systems and sects in the first several centuries of the common era: early Christianity, Gnosticism (of several kinds), the Valentinians and Kabbalah. All had something in common, but each had its own myths, texts, thoughts, beliefs, and ideas about salvation and Deity.

Among those Pike reviewed, the Manicheans are of particular note to Masons. Their founder, Mani (216-274 CE), focused on dualism, the constant struggle between opposites: good and evil; light and darkness; right and wrong. Indeed, Manicheanism’s explanation of the universe derived from two gods: a true Creator God and an evil god. Its myths, explanations and teachings were as elaborate (and as believable or unbelievable) as any faith system. Manicheanism experienced growth and acceptance in many parts of the world for several centuries.

For the Mason, the Manichean’s focus on dualism is familiar. Our ritual addresses contrasts in life: right vs. wrong, good vs. evil, light vs. dark, virtue vs. vice,

action vs. complacency, “the high, the low; the rich, the poor,” etc.

Yet the Fraternity is one of monotheists. The observed dualism of life does not extend to Belief. We hear the voice of Mani in the 18th degree, Knight Rose Croix, “...thus it is that faith and distrust, hope and doubt, each alternate like day and night, summer and winter... whereupon the ancients believed that no single god of love and goodness existed; but two, one of the principle of Good and one of the principle of evil; each in eternal alteration, conquering and overcoming, and that it would be so forever...”

We next hear the Fraternity’s unequivocal reply, “but we do not believe it so...” In facing the world’s dualism, we remain monotheists.

On another important level, Freemasonry contrasts dualism by emphasizing triads and groups threes. Wisdom, Strength and Beauty. Intellect, Power, Harmony. Three Grand Masters. Three primary degrees.

Dualism may describe the environment, but Freemasonry uses triads to find the path forward. We believe in One, but concern ourselves with threes.

Pike’s lecture well-summarizes references to triads found in many religions (including those of Manicheanism). Hence, we may understand the full name of the 26th degree, “Prince of Mercy, or Scottish Trinitarian.”

The Valley of Tampa regularly meets at its Center in Tampa on the 2nd Monday of each month. Dinner is served at 5:45 PM and the regular meeting starts at 7:00 PM. The annual Feast of Tishri will be presented at our October 14th meeting.

The Importance of Lawn Mower Safety

Shriners Hospitals Wants Kids to Stay Safe

Shriners Hospitals for Children® is committed to helping keep kids safe, and injury-free.

Although they may seem like a common household tool, lawn mowers are one of the most dangerous items in our homes. Thousands of people are hurt while using lawnmowers each year – these injuries can include deep cuts; loss of fingers, toes, and even limbs; burns and broken bones. However, many lawn mower-related injuries can be prevented by following some safety guidelines.

Lawnmower Usage Safety Tips

Keep Children Safe

- Children under 6 years of age should be kept indoors during mowing.
- Make sure children are a safe distance away from the area you plan to mow because rocks and debris often can shoot out while the lawn mower is running.
- Keep a close eye on children when a lawn mower is in use. Make sure they do not run into the mower's path.
- Never allow children to play with the mower, even when it is turned off. A lawn mower is not a toy.
- Children should be at least 12 years old before operating a walk-behind lawn mower and at least 16 years old to operate a riding mower.
- Never allow children or any other passengers on a riding lawn mower because of the potential for falling under the mower and sustaining serious injuries.

Weather and Terrain

- Do not cut grass when it's wet because it can cause your feet to lose traction and slide.
- Do not use a mower on hills or slopes, to avoid having it tip over and cause injury.

Prior to Mowing

- Read your mower's instruction manual and familiarize yourself with the product prior to use.
- Use a mower with a control that stops it from moving forward if the handle is released.
- Clear your lawn of items such as nails, sticks, rocks, toys, sports entertainment, dog bones, wire and equipment parts, so the debris does not cause damage or hurt anyone.

During Usage

- Wear close-fitting long pants and long-sleeved shirts, eye protection and heavy gloves.
- Do not wear sandals or be barefoot. Wear sturdy shoes with good traction.
- Do not wear jewelry.
- Always fill and start lawn mowers outdoors.
- Never fill the tank with gasoline when the lawn mower is on or hot.
- Do not remove safety devices or guards on switches.
- Never reach underneath a mower because the blade remains engaged even when it is shut off.
- Do not mow in reverse unless absolutely necessary.
- To remove debris from mower use a stick or broom handle, not your hands.
- Always shut off the engine before leaving the mower unattended.
- Stay away from the engine cowling, as it can become very hot and burn unprotected flesh.
- Wait for blades to stop completely before crossing gravel roads, unclogging the chute, or removing the grass catcher.

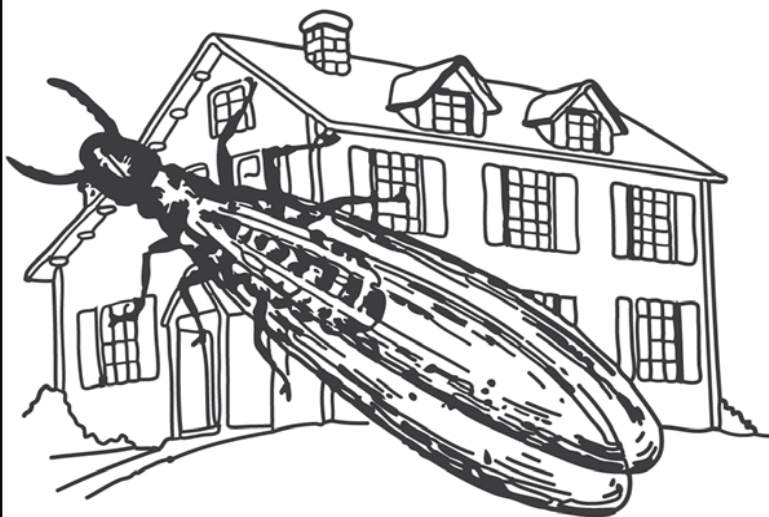
